(Horse must be registered with Racing Australia & compete with racing name)

Off the Track NSW – AM5 100cm

(Horse must be registered with Racing Australia & compete with racing name)

OFF THE TRACK RULES

Off The Track is open to all Thoroughbreds that have been lodged in a stable return for pre training and race preps, have officially raced or barrier trialed, locally, nationally or internationally. All horses are required to be 3 years and over and be no less than 14.2hh. All horses will be **Registered with Racing Australia**. Registrations and stable returns for those that did not make it to the races will be checked.

Racing Name is to be used, other than those that were unnamed due to injuries etc, during pre-training.

Random drug testing may be carried out.

The committee reserves the right to refuse an entry without assigning any reason for doing so and to alter the programme/schedule at their discretion.

Horses will be judged as a good example of a thoroughbred, rather than that of a riding horse/hunter type, with the following taken into consideration; thoroughbred qualities, conformation, manners, paces and performance

Injuries caused through racing, such as blemishes are allowed.
